Notice on Visitor Parking


To ensure an unobstructed Emergency Vehicle Access (EVA)¹, the following parking measures will continue to be enforced, effective from 1 January 2024.

Zone A - No visitor parking at all times, except for service, staff, and resident vehicles.

Zone B - Visitor parking allowed during authorized hours.

Zone A includes driveways alongside the SIP building, Glass Pavilion, tennis courts, Sports & Dormitory building, Chapel, IB building, gate, and the parking area behind the tuckshop. **Zone B** includes the Grass Paving Area, such as parking spots outside the auditorium, school field, and PD roundabout.

¹ **Obstruction of means of escape** - In relation to any premises, a person commits an offence if the person— (a) sets out or leaves or causes to be set out or left; or (b) being the owner, tenant, occupier or person in charge of the premises, permits or suffers to be set out or left, any article or thing that obstructs or may obstruct the means of escape in respect of the premises. A person who commits an offence under this section shall be liable— (a) on a first conviction, to a fine at level 6; (b) on a subsequent conviction, to a fine of \$200,000 and to imprisonment for 1 year, and, in any case, to a further fine of \$20,000 for each day during which the offence continues.
